Census Day is Sunday 21 March 2021.

The census gives us a picture of all the people and households in England and Wales. It gathers vital information that helps plan and fund public services, such as transport, education and healthcare.

By taking part and encouraging others to do the same, you will help make sure your community gets the services it needs.

It's easy to fill in your census questionnaire online.

1. We'll send you a pack in the post at the start of March with a **household access code**.
2. Go to **www.census.gov.uk** and select **"Start census"**.
3. **Enter your household access code**.
4. Answer the questions and **submit when complete**.



There will be plenty of free help available for people who need it, including:

- guidance and support in many languages, including British Sign Language (BSL)
- help in local Census Support Centres
- field staff visiting households to support completion
- paper questionnaires available on request
- large-print questionnaires and guidance
- braille guidance booklets
- an easy read information leaflet containing accessible messages and pictures
