

Minutes of the Molescroft Parish Council Meeting held at 7:00 pm, Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022, at the Molescroft Pavilion.

#### 2458. Apologies

Apologies were received from Councillors Yates, Coates, Burrows, and Pinder.

#### 2459. Declarations of Interest

No declarations of interest were made.

# 2460. Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the 17<sup>th</sup> February 2022 meeting had been circulated and were approved as a true record of proceedings.

## 2461. Action Log/Matters Arising (All)

The action log for March 2022 was presented with updates; work continues in the remaining areas. An application for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Fund will now be worked on. Publicity photos for the presentation of the Millennium Cup to be arranged.

### 2462. Correspondence Received/Actioned (Clerk)

The Clerk presented a range of correspondence items received since the last Parish Council meeting. These items were for information, action, consultation and response. The Clerk advised that where possible responses had been provided to the agencies/people in question. A discussion took place in relation to the items of key correspondence received and direction given by Council. The following items were discussed:

- A request for a contribution towards a trip to the 2023 World Scout Jamboree all agreed.
- A query received from a member of the public concerned about possible encroachment from residential properties onto amenity land. Passed to Ward Councillor to investigate further.
- Response received from ERYC Streetscene Services regarding the over-pruning of hedges and planted areas in the parish – to be followed up.
- Email received from ERYC regarding sustainable travel Clerk to look into application for bike racks at the Pavilion.
- Various correspondence regarding the planting of wild flower meadows project is progressing, group to attend the Parish Council meeting in May.

### 2463. Update from Ward Councillor

Councillor Healy provided an update, noting the following:

- New trees have been planted in the parish. Cllr Healy will look into the over-pruning of trees and hedges.
- Planning application for Land West of 221 Woodhall Way went to appeal and was not approved.
- Councillor Healy was requested to investigate the present position re. the planning application for the change of use of the amenity land which has been outstanding for more than a year. The Los land appeared to include the frontage trees but a fence has been erected excluding the trees which now appear to have been included in the highway land for maintenance by ERYC. None of the other residents appear to have tidied up the land which according to the applicant will be offered to them.

### 2464. Payment of Accounts (Clerk)

The Clerk updated the Council regarding current payments for March 2022. Payments made for March 2022 were £6,874.07.

The following was noted:

- Back-pay owed to the Clerk and Pavilion Manager for recently agreed pay increase, applicable from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021.
- Annual Commercial Insurance renewal, £1,113.56.

The accounts were agreed for payment and the Chairman and Clerk (Responsible Financial Officer) signed the payment schedule as a correct record.

#### 2465. Planning Applications (Clerk)

The Clerk advised that all planning applications received had been shared with Councillors for comment. All comments received had been submitted to ERYC within the required timescales.

Cllr Fleming advised that there has yet been no further progress with the installation of charity clothing banks – they are awaiting information regarding the next steps.

Cllr Fleming advised that the Parish Council will be looking further into an issue of non-payment for the hire of the Pavilion hall.

Cllr Lockyer has received some enquiries about the possibility of a newsletter for local residents who do not have access to the internet. Options and costs to be looked into.
