1683. Declarations of Interest.

Councillor Jackson on item 1690 Pavilion Extension Buildover agreement due to previous involvement with YWA on legal issues.

1684. Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting.

The minutes of the meeting of 15th May 2017 had been circulated and were approved as a true record of proceedings.

1685. Matter arising from the Parish Council meeting on the 15th May 2017

Minute -Councillor Boynton raised the point that the offer from Beverley Braves to have a Councillor sit on their committee was dependent on the Parish Council helping with funding.

1690. Pavilion Extension

Councillor Jackson left the room during discussions and decision.

Copies of the draft legal agreement had been circulated prior to the meeting. The draft legal agreement was agreed subject to the points raised by the Councils Solicitor and confirmation that the plan numbers were correct.

Agreed – Draft Build over agreement agreed, Chairman authorised to sign agreement on behalf of the Council.

1691. Website

Councillor Lockyer raised concerns about the lack of progress on updating the website and suggested that the Council should explore other options in order to make the required improvements.

Councillor Linthwaite was aware of a number of providers who could possibly meet the Councils requirements, and offered to circulate the details to Councillors in order to access the sites for comparison before the next meeting.

Agreed – Councillor Linthwaite to circulate details of website providers to all Councillors before the next meeting.

1692. Drop Boxes

Councillor Heffer reported that she has been trying to make progress on having the drop boxes removed from around the Parish for over a year with little success, she suggested that the Council should now write to the Royal Mail.

Agreed – Letter to be sent to The Royal Mail Action – Clerk

1693. Hire charge – meeting room

The Clerk had received comments from users and potential hirers that the hire charge for the Pavilion meeting room was to high for the size of the room, and that larger better equipped rooms can be found elsewhere at a similar or lower rate. He suggested that a hire charge of £8.50 would be more appropriate to help maintain the current level of use.

It was agreed that the charge should be reconsidered and Councillor Hanneman proposed a charge of £8.00 be made for the first hour and £6.00 for all subsequent hours. Seconded Councillor Heffer.

Agreed – The hire rate for the Pavilion meeting room be revised to £8.00 and hour for the first hour of the booking reducing to £6.00 for all subsequent hours.

Action – Clerk to implement

1694. Matters arising from Annual Parish Council

Dogs on leash – The number of dogs not on leashes on the Pavilion grounds was a concern to a resident particularly as children are regularly using the facilities. Councillors agreed that this is an issue that should be considered, enforcement being the main issue. The Clerk was asked to seek advice from the ERYC dog warden.

Agreed – ERYC dog wardens be contacted for advice

Action - Clerk

Fenced of area for dog walking at the Pavilion – This was considered to be to impractical in terms of enforcement and cleaning.

Sylvester Lane (Beverley) – As this lane is in Beverley Town Councillor Jackson had taken this up as an individual with ERYC Joint Local Action Forum.

1695. Feedback from meetings attended

Councillor Heffer had met with the cleaners and although the standard had improved it was still not to the required standard and they were not doing the hours contracted for. It was agreed that the services of the contract be ceased.
